

## SAS Case 6 - if/then/else

### Problem Statement

In this case you'll modify (temporarily) the data set used in case 4A. Due to expansion at Bisco, all individuals that work in the Main Building will move to the newly constructed Bisco Building. The move involves divisions BB5A and TIG. Change the value for LOCATION for divisions BB5A and TIG from "MAIN BUILDING" to "BISCO BUILDING".

### Your Task

1. Start with the JCL/SAS file you used in Case 4A  
**YOUR\_USER\_ID.TRAINING.CASE4A.**
2. Use if/then statements to change the value for LOCATION for divisions BB5A and TIG from "MAIN BUILDING" to "BISCO BUILDING".
3. Print out the revised division list using PROC PRINT.
4. Save the JCL and SAS code as file **YOUR\_USER\_ID.TRAINING.CASE6.**

When the SAS job runs successfully, print out:

1. The original JCL/SAS file (**YOUR\_USER\_ID.TRAINING.CASE6**).
2. The SAS listing (shown as SASLIST in IOF)
